


Feed production of 482,000 tonnes in 2021 – Self-sufficient in Europe






Farming harvest volumes of 466,000 GWT in 2021

Sales & Marketing – Consumer Products volumes of 248,000 tonnes in 2021



 - With the best climate footprint and top sustainability performance vs. all other animal proteins (Coller FAIRR Index 2021)




Farming volume growth is thus high on the agenda

- Current intrinsic harvest capacity for Mowi Farming is well beyond 500k GWT
 - 2021: 466k GWT
- Post-smolt programme in Norway to deliver 40k GWT extra harvest volumes in Norway by 2027, all else being equal
 - Projects undertaken to date account for 41% of the post-smolt programme
- Will address post-smolt in Scotland as well
- Other organic growth initiatives
- Accretive M&A
- Monitoring new farming technologies closely
