The #FocusAsia SME Study-trip enables Swedish SMEs to discover their potential in Indian market

What is it?

The Focus Asia SME Study-trip is a **5-day program** in China covering Shanghai, Hangzhou and Shenzhen, where participants will have a firsthand experience of opportunities in one of the largest, most dynamic and influential markets in the world.

The program will take participants through a **well-curated and dedicated meeting program** to learn from leading companies, industrial associations and governmental agencies in the country about **how to enter and succeed in China**.



Note: SME defined as < 250 employees, turnover < EUR 50 mn, not subsidiary of large corporation.

SHANGHAI



Shanghai is China's gateway to global business and one of the world's leading commercial and financial centers. Bringing together multinational companies, innovative startups, investors, and research institutions, the city offers a unique opportunity to understand how innovation is translated into business growth.

Meetings with leading organizations and companies will give participants insights into the trends and strategies shaping both the Chinese market and the global economy.

HANGZHOU



Hangzhou is the heart of China's digital economy and home to technology leaders such as Alibaba. The city showcases how advances in AI, e-commerce, fintech, and digital services are transforming industries and consumer behavior.

Visiting Hangzhou and engaging with local companies offers first-hand exposure to one of the world's most advanced digital innovation ecosystems.

SHENZHEN



Shenzhen is China's innovation engine and a global hub for technology development and advanced manufacturing. Known for its entrepreneurial culture and ability to rapidly turn ideas into products, the city is home to some of China's most influential technology companies.

Through visits and meetings with pioneering businesses, participants will experience how innovation moves from concept to commercialization at an exceptional speed and scale.

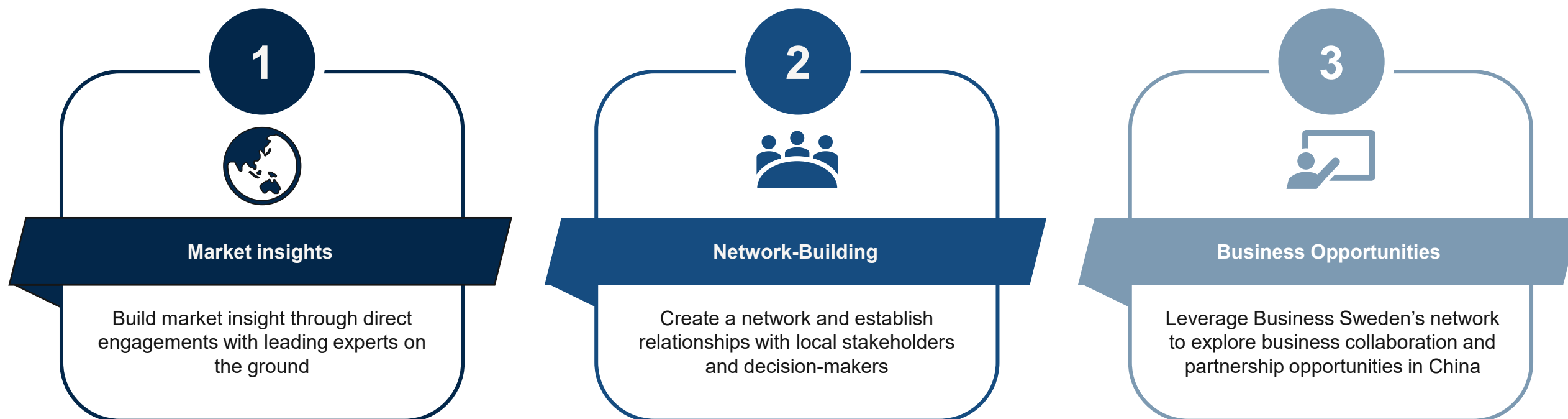
